Sec. 2-1-1 Village Government.

The Village of La Farge is a body corporate and politic with the powers of a municipality at common law and governed by the provisions of Chapters 61 and 66 of the Wisconsin Statutes, laws amending those chapters, other acts of the legislature and the Constitution of the State of Wisconsin.

Sec. 2-1-2 Election Poll Hours.

The voting polls in the Village of La Farge, Vernon County, Wisconsin shall be opened from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. for all elections.

Sec. 2-1-3 Election Officials.

Pursuant to the Wisconsin Statutes, there is hereby established one (1) set of election officials to conduct all elections in the two (2) wards of the Village which shall consist of seven (7) election inspectors. However, the Village Clerk shall have the power to limit the number of election officials. The Clerk shall determine in advance of each election whether the number of election officials for such election should be reduced from the number prescribed by the Wisconsin Statutes, and if such a reduction is so determined, the Clerk shall further redistribute duties among the remaining officials.

Sec. 2-1-4 Nomination for Elective Village Offices.

Nomination of candidates to the offices of the Village President and Village Trustee shall be by nomination papers, circulated in accordance with Sec. 8.10, Wis. Stats., and in complete conformity therewith.
